## Discussion Guide

1. How many owls appear in the story? What are the roles of each and how what metaphors have owls portrayed in both mythology and mysticism?
2. What historical medieval reference is the owl flying through the great hall?
3. How is the story commentary on ideological and cultural perceptions of beauty?
4. What is the numerological significance of the date of the dinner party and what other significant celestial events happen on specific dates of the annual calendar which are considered spiritual portals?
5. What is mirror writing and what is its genetic basis?
6. What chapter features a nod to the imprint that published The Dream Mirrors? (Chapter 17, dreams exist in our inner realm)
7. What is the origin of the word kaleidoscope and how does it fit into the story as a metaphor of perspective?
8. In chapter 28, Hannah records her dream, gives it a title, and then analyzes the content. Try out this exercise with your own dream record.
9. What is Imni is Irish for what word in English? Discuss the psychological background and benefits of this concept.

## Discussion Guide Part 2

1. What is the concept of transmutation and how can it be understood in a spiritual sense. How does the Imni Tree play into this process?
2. What role does quantum physics play in the story. Describe the concept of quantum entanglement and decoherence.
3. All astronomical phenomena in the series, including eclipses, electromagnetic solar storms and sightings of Aurora Borealis, align with real-life occurrences. Explain Mercury Retrograde. (How often does it happen? How often does it overlap with Halloween? What are the signs? What role does it play in the series?)
4. What is lithotherapy and what stones does Hannah discover which aid her?
5. The story reflects upon the themes of insecurity and vanity through the integration of the mythological story of Narcissus. What parts of Ovid's story mirror the events of The Dream Mirrors and what flower is featured that is tied to this historic name?
6. Discuss the quantum physics concepts of coherence and decoherence in relation to the story.
7. Explain the atmospheric phenomenon of the moonbow at the end of Chapter 30 and why it fits into the story.
8. How many dreams are there in the story? What's the significance of the number?
9. 9/9/9 is the last set of repeating, single-digit dates that we'll see for almost a century (until January 1, 2101), or a millennium (mark your calendars for January 1, 3001), depending on how you want to count it. What Greek mathematician popularized numerology in ancient times? (Pythagoras)
